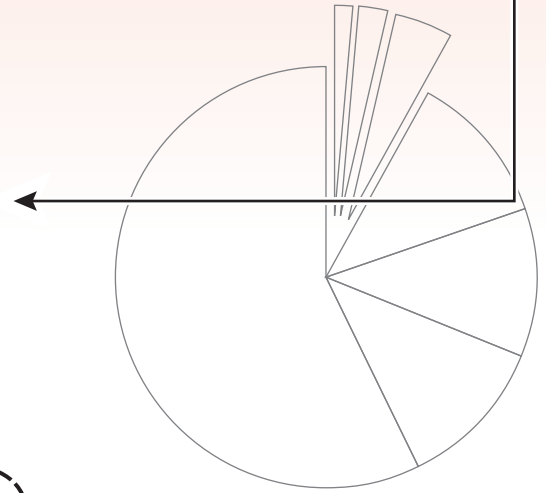


Communicating climate change - how to do it right!
